- Drawings only, **no text**
- Only ONE entry per student
- Suggestion: Large outlined shapes and solid colors work best for banner designs.

Colored markers work best for design submissions.

Three winners (1st, 2nd, and 3rd) will be selected from each Grade category:

Grade K-2	Grade 3-4
Grade 5-6	Grade 7-8

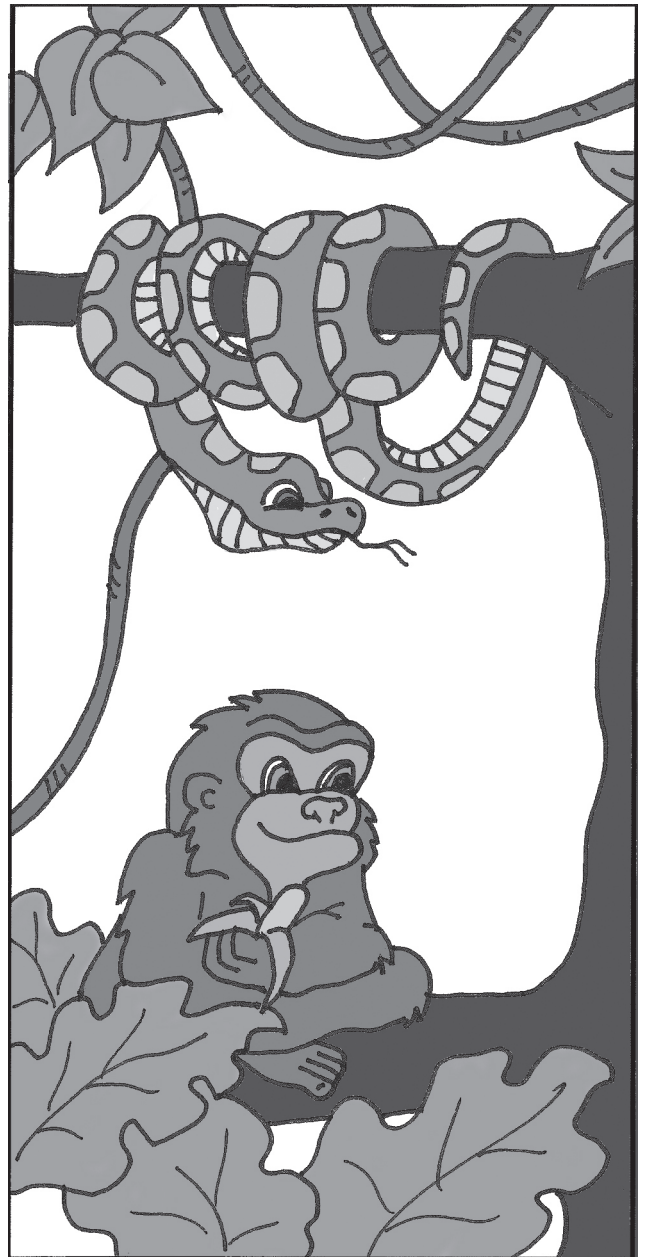
- All Winners from each grade category will paint their designs on actual banner material for display on Postoffice Street.
